1) Wear warm clothing in several loose layers.

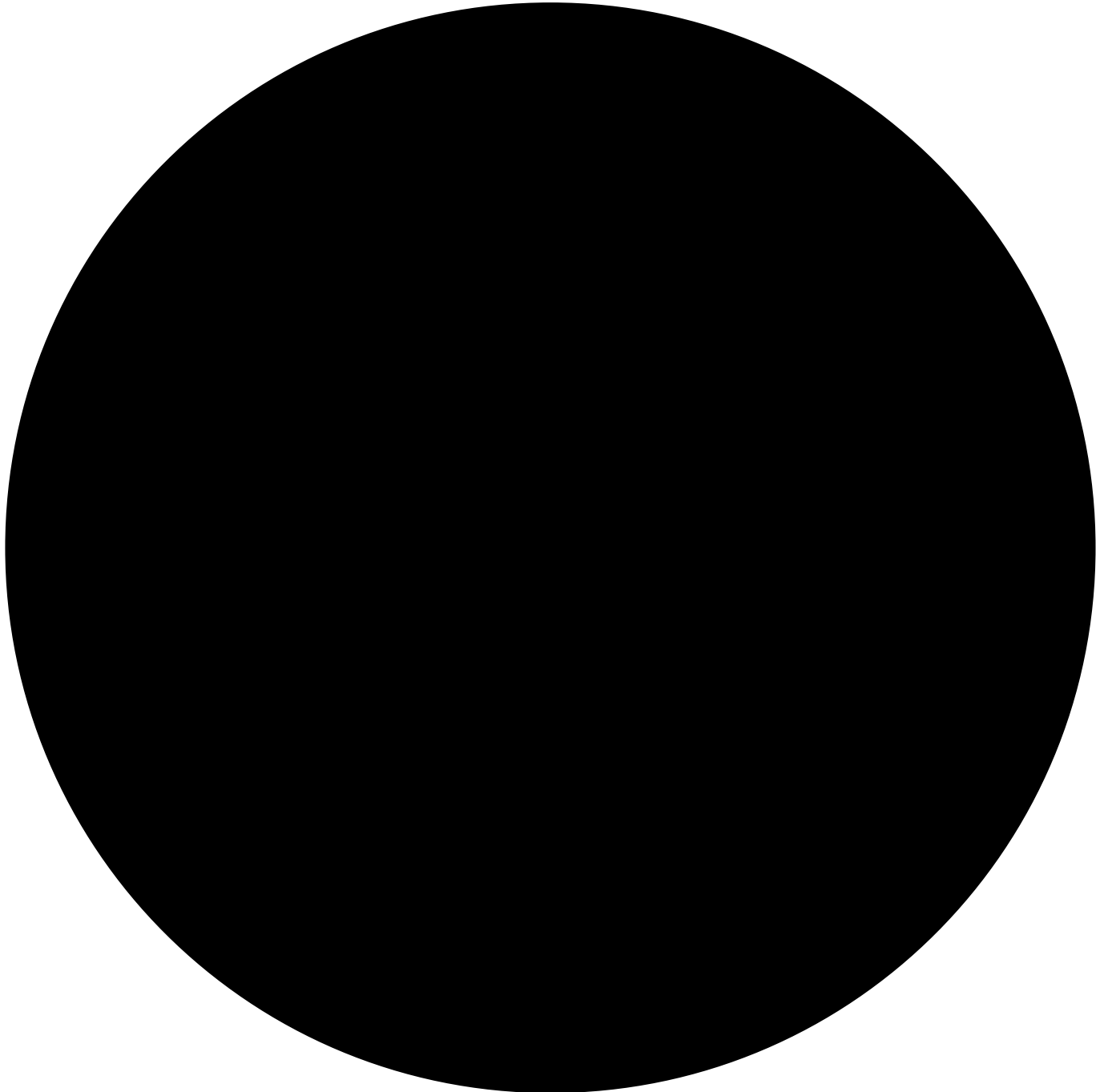
- Wear a tightly woven, preferably wind-resistant coat or jacket; inner layers of light, warm clothing; mittens; hats; and scarves.

3) Stay dry—wet clothing chills the body rapidly. Too much perspiration will increase heat loss, so remove extra layers of clothing whenever you feel too warm.

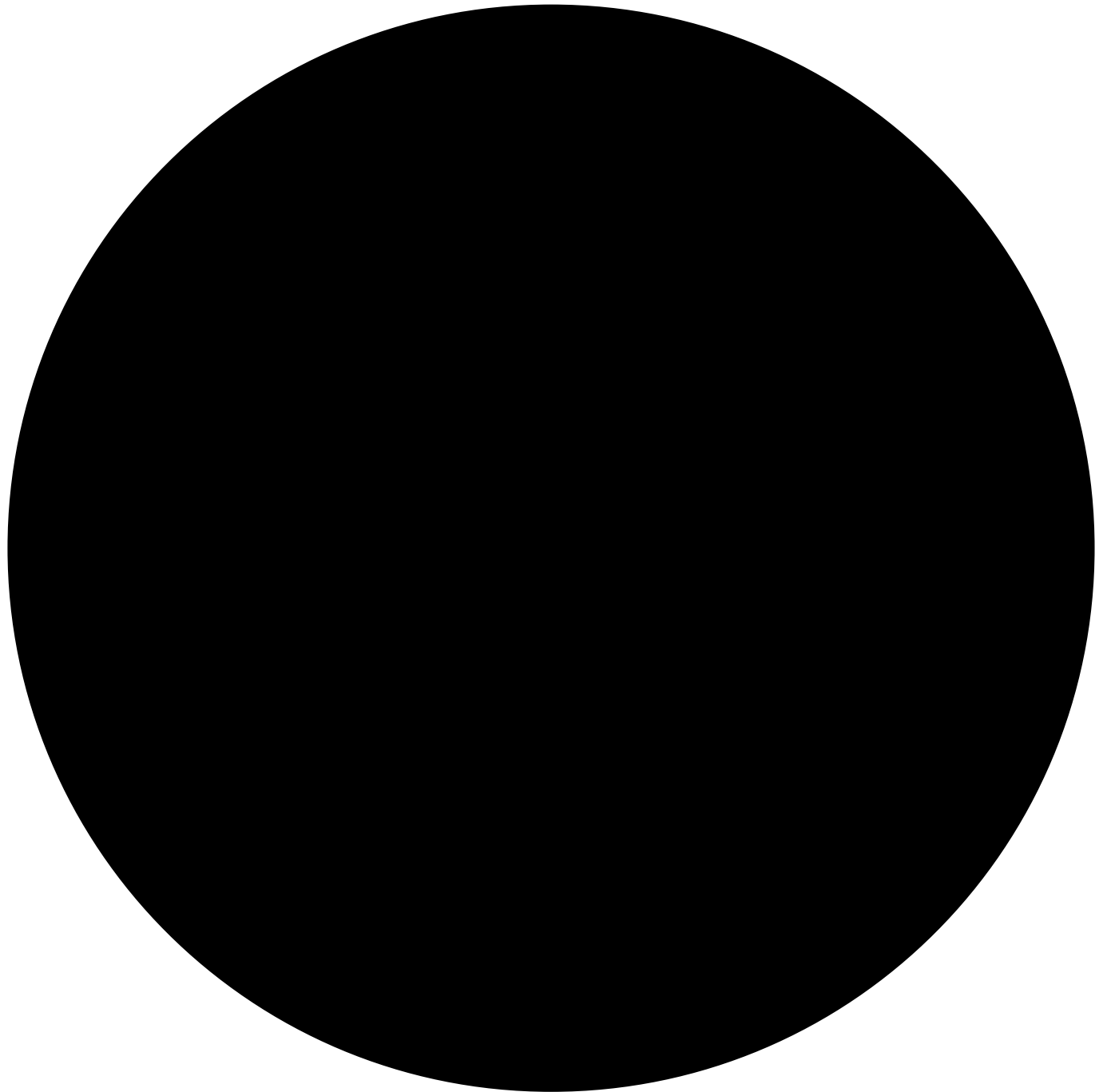
4) Do not ignore shivering. It's an important first sign that the body is losing heat. Persistent shivering is a signal to return indoors.
