Use: As soon as:

Rules:

- 1. By using as soon as we can join two separate sentences.
- 2. Write As soon as before the sentence which shows first action.
- 3. If in given single sentence there is a (as, when, or No sooner + helping verb) remove it and in place of it put as soon and connect other sentence by putting comma (,).
- 1. The driver saw a green signal. He started his car.

Ans: As soon as the driver saw a green signal, he started his car.

Formula: No sooner + Helping verb + s. +v. than (join another sentence) do, does, did.

e.g. 1. The driver saw a green signal. He started his car.

Ans: No sooner did the driver see a green signal than he started his car.
