### Extension Activities:

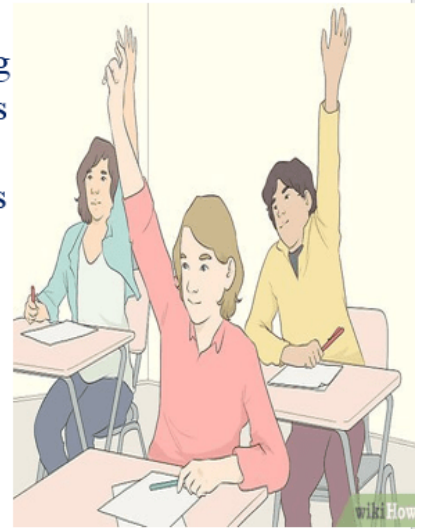
1. Imagine you meet Manav. Ask him to tell his experiences about collecting money.
