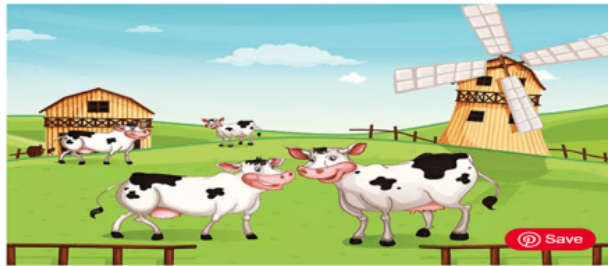
Meaning:
