#### Alliteration (अनुप्रास अलंकार):

# Alliteration is the repetition of the beginning (Consonant) sounds of neighbouring words.

यो अलंकारात भाषेचा गोडवा, सौंदयय, गैयता वाढवण्योकरता समान व्यंजन ध्वनींची पुनरारुत्ती केली जाते.

#### **Examples:**

- (1) Each day brings new beginnings,
- (2) Travel down the darkened road,
- 3) Bring out the best in me.
- (4) That life is lived its very best.

- (5) And fit for life each day
- (6) I want to sow many, small, small moons of light.
- (7) The route is tough and full of snakes and scorpions.
- (8) I want to sow seeds of moon on the sides of the path.
- (9) O moon, give me moonlight, basketful of two basket full.
- (10) O moon give me a basketful of moonlight on loan.
- (11) You start dying slowly...
- (12) In form and feature, face and limb.
- $(\sqrt{3})$  It puzzled all our kith and kin,
- (4) One day, to make the matter worse.

- (15) Our close resemblance turned the tide
- (16) Became my brother's wife.
- (17) As we were being washed by nurse.
- (18) With sixty seconds' worth of distance run.
- (19) With worn-out tools.
- (20) The only other sound's the sweep.
- (21) The woods are lovely, dark and deep.
- (22) And then I stopped to buy some sweets
- (23) With eyes to see the sunset's glow
- (24) The ship is anchored safe and sound, its voyage closed and done.
- (25) It is some dream that on the deck.

## Repetition (पुनरावृत्ती अलंकार)

words are repeated in a sentence for pleasing or musical effect, the figure of speech is Repetition.

(या अलंकारात काव्याचे सौंदययं व त्यातील माधुयंय वाढवण्याकरता शबदांचा पुनःपुन्हा उपयोग केलेला असतो.)

### Examples:

- (1) Small, small moons of light.
- (2) I want to sow many, small, small moons of light.
- (3) In fact, year after year the same.
- (4) And yet don't look too good, nor talk too wise.

- (5) O Captain! My Captain! our fearful trip is done;
- (6) But O heart! heart! heart!
- (8) O Captain! My Captain! rise up and hear the bells.
- (9) Rise up-for you the flag is flung-for you the bugle trills.
- (10) For you bouquets and ribbon'd wreaths-for you the shores a-crowding.
