(4) **to run away** - □□□□ □□□□ (March. 2020)

The thief **ran away** from jail.

(5) **to be proud of** - □□ □□□□□□ □□□□

I am proud of my country.

(6) to be afraid of - डर डराने डराने

Most of the people **are afraid of** ghosts and darkness.

(7) to be fond of - डर डर डर

He **is fond of** playing cricket.

He **got rid of** the bad company.

(14) to be known as - डरडर डरडर **(March. 2020)**

Dr. Abdul Kalam **is known as** Missile Man.

(15) in a flash - डरडरडरडरडर (in a moment)

It was done in a flash.

(23) to root out - അന്വേഷിക്കുക/അന്വേഷിക്കുക

It is necessary **to root out** the evils from the society.

(24) to be able to - കഴിയുക

Radha **is able to** speak English fluently.
