**(6) to be afraid of** - डर डराने डराने

Most of the people **are afraid of** ghosts and darkness.

**(7) to be fond of** - डर डर डर

He **is fond of** playing cricket.

He **is good at** sports and games.

**(9) to be eager to** - डरडरडर डरडर

The children **are eager to** see the circus.

My house is **in front of** my school.

He **got rid of** the bad company.

**(14) to be known as** - डरडर डरडर **(March. 2020)**

Dr. Abdul Kalam **is known as** Missile Man.

**(15) in a flash** - डरडरडरडरडर (in a moment)

It was done in a flash.

It is necessary **to root out** the evils from the society.

**(24) to be able to** - കഴിയുക

Radha **is able to** speak English fluently.

He was **in search of** a new job.

The young man could not **muster up courage** to climb the tree.
