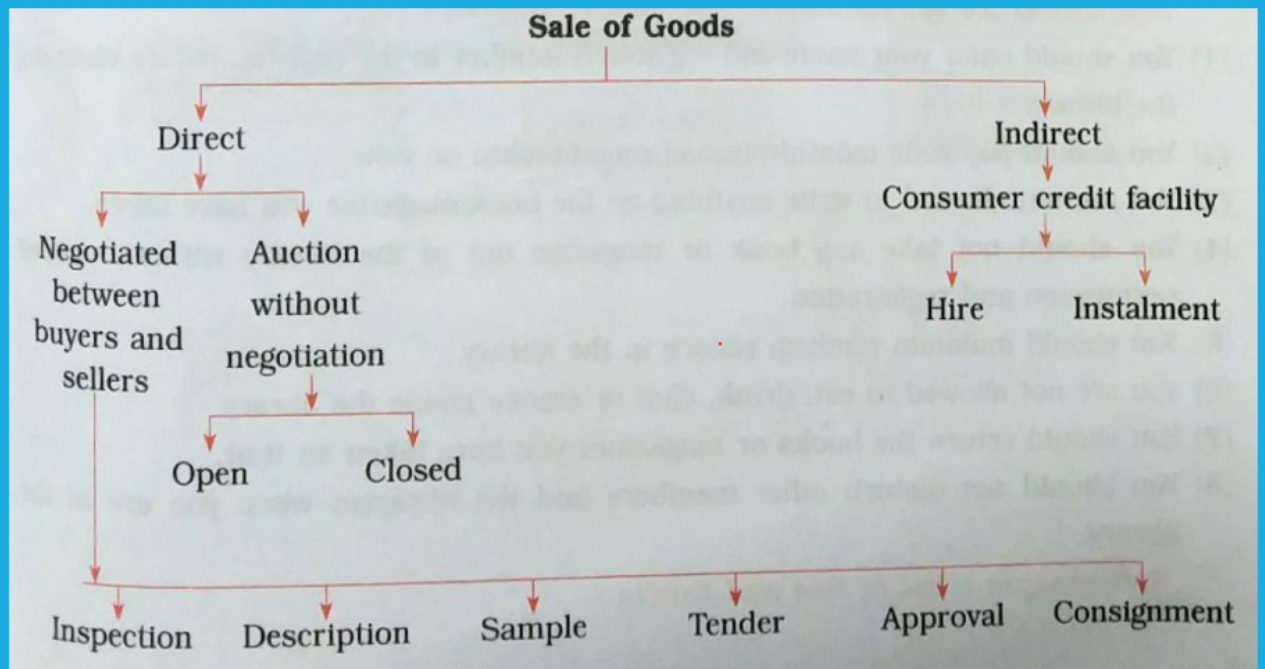

Several methods are used for the sale of goods. Some methods are direct while others are indirect. Broadly these methods can be classified into 3 types. Negotiated sale is the sale completed by negotiation between the buyer and seller. Auction sale is direct sale but without any negotiation. The third method is the system of consumer credit facility which again can be either hire-purchase system or instalment method. Negotiated sale can take place through inspection, by description, by sample, by tender, by approval and on consignment. Auction sales are carried out by two methods, viz. open auction and closed auction.
