WH Question Words

We use question words to ask certain types of questions.

We often refer to these words as WH words because they include the letters WH (for example Why, How).

1) What : काय

- asking for information about something.
- asking for repetition or confirmation.
- 1) What is your name?
- 2) What are you doing?
- 3) What is that?

2) When: केव्हा

* asking about time.

- 1) When did he leave the village?
- 2) When will he return from Delhi?
- 3) When will you come back?

3) Where: कुढे

* asking in or at what place or position.

- 1) Where do they live?
- 2) Where is your new car?
- 3) Where is your school bag?

4) Which: कोणता , कोणते , कोणत्या

* asking about choice.

- 1) Which colour do you want?
- 2) Which is your favourite colour?

5) Who: कोण

* asking what or which person or people (subject).

- 1) Who opened the door?
- 2) Who won the match?

6) Whom: कोणाला

- * asking what or which person or people (object).
- 1) Whom did you see?
- 2) Whom will you help?

7) Whose: कोणाच्या

- * asking about ownership.
- 1) Whose are these keys?
- 2) Whose turn, is it?

8) Why: का ?

- * asking for reason, asking what...for.
- 1) Why do you say that?
- 2) Why are you late?
- 3) Why the students are making noise?

9) How: <mark>कसा</mark>

- * asking about manner.
- * asking about condition or quality.
- 1) How does this work?
- 2) How was your exam?

10) How far: किती दूर

- * distance
- 1) How far is Pattaya from Bangkok?

11) How long: किती वेळ

- * length (time or space)
- 1) How long will it take?

12) How many: किती

- * quantity (countable)
- 1)How many cars are there?

13) How much: किती

- * quantity (uncountable)
- 1) How much money do you have?

14) How old: वय किती

- * age
- 1) How old are you?
