I talked with him, he seemed so calm, and if I were late, it would do no harm,

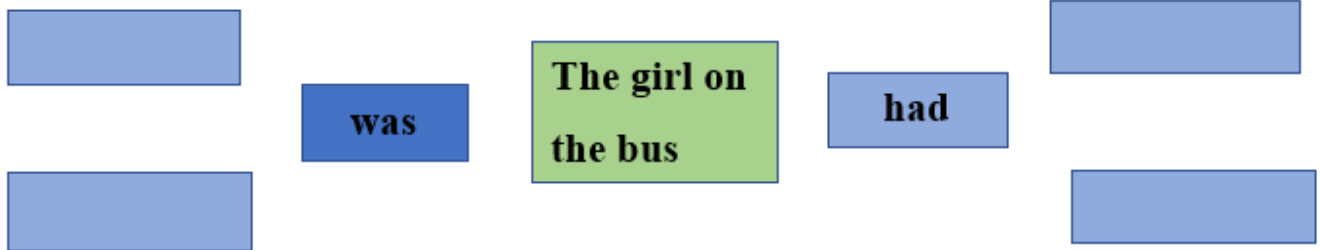
And as I left he said to me "I thank you, you have been so kind"

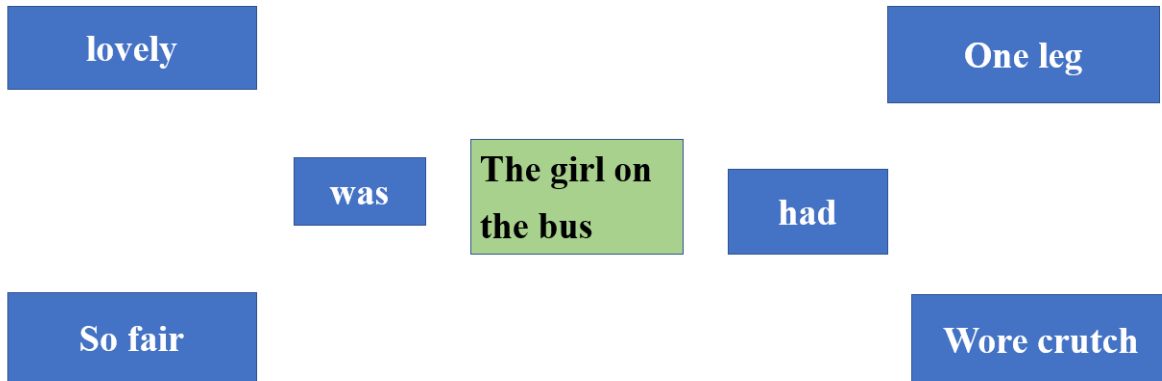
