

Developing a story/Narrating an experience with a given beginning or end.

Tips for writing a story:

- या प्रश्नात एखादी गोष्ट किंवा जीवनात आलेला अनुभव लिहायचा असतो.

- घटना किंवा तुम्हांला आलेला अनुभव घडून गेलेला आहे त्यामुळे या प्रश्नाच्या उत्तराचे लेखन भूतकाळात करावे.
- कथेला/अनुभवाला योग्य शीर्षक द्यावे. गाभा घटकात कथेतील महत्त्वाचे मुद्दे लिहावेत व संपूर्ण कथा, अनुभव किंवा घटना तुम्ही स्वतः अनुभवली आहे, असे लेखन होणे गरजेचे आहे.
